

City Council Update



Mayor Wayne Stuart opened the April meeting by delivering the Invocation and led the Council and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. After the committee reports were heard the City Council took action on the following agenda items:

- **1** Approved An Ordinance amending Rogue River Municipal Code Chapter <u>18.10</u>, Annexation procedures for the City of Rogue River, Oregon.
- **2** Approved a Resolution adopting an Employee Handbook for the City of Rogue River, Oregon, and rescinding Resolution No. 17-1310-R and 17-1312-R.
- 3 Approved a new franchise agreement between the City and Southern Oregon Sanitation Inc. Who is seeking a general rate increase for solid waste collection service.
- 4 Approved a request for an Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for Temporary Use of an Annual License for a special event being held on May 14-15, 2021 at 410 East Main Street, Rogue River, Oregon. Applicant: Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4116, David Green, House Committee Chair.

- **5** Approved a request from the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4116 to waive the Liquor License application fee for the special event being held on May 14-15, 2021.
- 6 Approved a request for a new Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for Stanlee's, LLC, at 108 Depot Street, Rogue River, Oregon. Applicant: Julie Cornella, Owner.

PERMIT COST: \$2.00

You are allowed 4-sales per year each for 3-consecutive days. Signs must be posted on private property with permission from the property owner. It is illegal to post ANY sign on a utility pole, stop sign, or sidewalk by anyone other than the City or a Utility Company. Violators of the Code can be cited into Court.



Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day and was initiated to honor the soldiers for the Union and Confederate armies who died during the American Civil War.

Celebrations honoring Civil War heroes started the year after the war ended. The establishment of a public holiday was meant to unify the celebration as a national day of remembrance instead of a holiday celebrated separately by the Union and Confederate states. By the late 19th century, the holiday became known as Memorial Day and was expanded to include the deceased veterans of all the wars fought by American forces. In 1971, Memorial Day became a federal holiday.

Join the Mayor, City Council and Staff in observing Memorial Day by remembering those that have given their lives to protect us and protect our freedom.
